from the Kazimierz Serocki 16th International Composers' Competition 2019

From 4th to 6th of October 2019 The Jury of the Kazimierz Serocki 16th International Composers' Competition 2019 took place in Radziejowice Palace near Warsaw.

144 (one hundred forty four) scores were sent to the Competition from all over the world.

The Jury: Fredrik Österling (Sweden), Paul Patterson (United Kingdom) and Dariusz Przybylski (Poland) decided to give the following prizes:

The FIRST Prize (13.000PLN) went to **JINSEOK CHOI** (SOUTH KOREA) – “**Pathos**”.

The SECOND Prize (8.000PLN) went to **ADAM VILAGI** (FINLAND) – “**Directions**”.

The THIRD Prize (4.000PLN) went to **HUGH COLLINS RICE** (GREAT BRITAIN) – “**Canto Celato**”.

Honorary Mentions: **Youngwoo, Yoo** (SOUTH KOREA), **Minzuo Lu** (CHINA), **Zhaoyu Zhang** (CHINA).

The prizes were funded by **The Ministry of Culture and National Heritage, The Authors' Society ZAiKS, The Witold Lutoslawski Society and Association for Polish Music Artists - SPAM.**
